Final Conference in Montenegro: Digitalisation Versus Corruption

25 May 2026 | Berane, Montenegro

As part of the **Digitalisation Versus Corruption DigitalVsCorrupt** project, the **Final Conference in Montenegro** will take place on **Monday, 25 May 2026**, in **Berane, Montenegro**.

The event will begin at 10:00 a.m. and will focus on presenting the results of the project, exchanging experiences, and discussing the role of digital tools in preventing and identifying corruption.

The project is implemented within **Erasmus Youth 2023 - Capacity Building in the Field of Youth - Western Balkans** and brings together organisations from different European countries and the Western Balkans. Its main aim is to strengthen the knowledge, competences and active role of young people in addressing corruption, with a particular focus on digitalisation, transparency and civic participation.

Purpose of the Final Conference

The Final Conference will be an important closing event of the project, presenting the key results, activities and learning outcomes developed within **DigitalVsCorrupt**. Participants will have the opportunity to learn about project experiences, examples of good practice and reflections on how digital tools can contribute to greater accountability, transparency and youth involvement in democratic processes.

Special attention will be given to the question of how young people, youth organisations and civil society can use digital approaches to help prevent corruption and strengthen trust in public institutions.

About the DigitalVsCorrupt Project

The **Digitalisation Versus Corruption** project addresses corruption as one of the key challenges of contemporary societies. Corruption negatively affects democratic processes, the rule of law, economic development and citizens' trust in institutions.

Through the project, the partners promote the use of digital tools, non-formal education and international cooperation to raise awareness among young people about the consequences of corruption and to develop concrete mechanisms that can contribute to a more transparent and accountable society.

International Partnership

The project brings together partners from several countries, including Montenegro, Slovenia, Germany and other European countries and countries of the Western Balkans. This cooperation enables the exchange of knowledge, experience and approaches to fighting corruption in different social contexts. The Final Conference in Berane will therefore also provide an opportunity to strengthen international dialogue, networking and further cooperation between organisations working in the fields of youth work, transparency, civic education and democratic participation.

Digitalisation as a Tool for Change

At a time when digital tools increasingly shape public life, communication and access to information, it is important for young people to understand them also as tools for social responsibility. The **DigitalVsCorrupt project** emphasises that digitalisation can contribute to greater transparency, more effective reporting of irregularities, public awareness and a more active role of young people in society.

The Final Conference will therefore serve as an important space for presenting the achievements of the project and reflecting on further steps in connecting digital solutions, youth work and the fight against corruption.
